Please follow these guidelines when using the club and tennis courts

Tennis play hours: 7am – 9pm

- The courts are for the enjoyment of all who attend the club - members, guests, visiting teams and spectators
- Non-member guests must first sign-in and pay the relevant guest fee before using the courts
- If playing under floodlights, tokens can be bought from the bar
- Appropriate attire, including athletic shoes are required to be worn
- Please check the court and the surroundings before use to ensure you are familiar with all the potential hazards and that you feel it is safe to play tennis
- Please be considerate and respectful to those around you on neighbouring courts and refrain from shouting and using inappropriate language
- Children under the age of 13 will require adult supervision
- If others are waiting, please limit your play to 1 ½ hours
- On leaving the court be mindful of others playing tennis and take all personal belongings, including any rubbish and tennis balls with you – leaving the court clean and safe for others

Smoke Free Environment

Bath Tennis Club promotes a smoke free environment. Please refrain from smoking on the club premises when there are children present. At all other times please use the designated areas outside the club main access gate.
